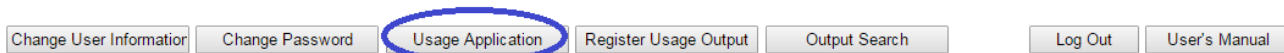


## Applying to Use Data (Graduate Students for Research)

- After logging in, User Page is displayed. Click on “Usage Application.”



- In the Search Bar located near the top of the usage application page, enter the survey number, survey title, or the name of the depositing institution for the data that you would like to use. If you would like to search data in detail, click on “Advanced Search” button. The results of your search will be displayed in the “List of Data” box below the Search Bar.
