### 1. Purpose of the SSJDA Seminar Series

The SSJDA seminars provide young researchers from overseas the opportunity to exchange research ideas and present their latest empirical research results in the field of social sciences, thereby building an international network of young researchers. Through this seminar series, SSJDA seeks to fund participants to accelerate the dissemination of international joint research and strengthen cooperation among overseas data archive networks.
